

## Thanksgiving Turkey Placeholders

These Thanksgiving Placeholders are easy to make, filled with crayons and a great way to entertain during Thanksgiving get-togethers. Not to mention, it provides kids with activities as they are waiting for the feast to start.

### What You'll Need

- A. One (1) log approximately 3" in diameter
- B. Ruler
- C. Pencil
- D. Hand Saw
- E. Drill with 3/8" Drill Bit
- F. Crayons
- G. Parental Supervision

### Assembly Instructions

1. Using the Ruler and Pencil, measure and mark your log into two inch (2") cookies.
2. With your parents' help, use the hand saw to cut through the log at your mark.
3. With your parents' help, use the drill and a 3/8" drill bit to drill five evenly spaced holes along one edge of the log cookie.
4. Place the crayons in the holes. These are the turkey feathers.
5. Using the crayons from step 4, draw two eyes and a beak on the flat side of the log. This is your turkey's face.
6. Repeat steps 1 through 5 for as many placeholders as you need.
